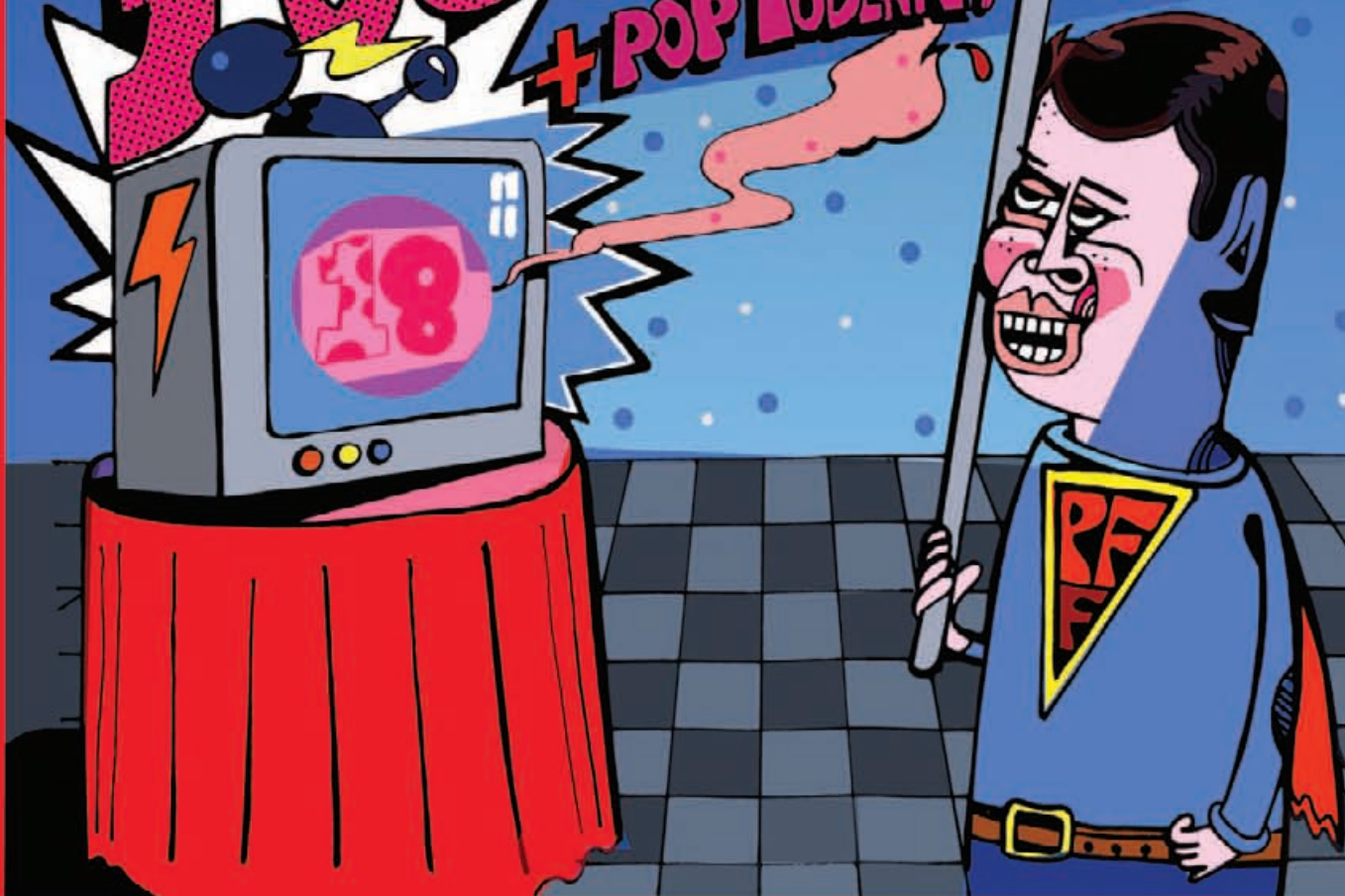

Robert Stevenson 1971 set in 1940 Disneyland Portobello market scene featuring a proto-Carnival song and dance routine.



## It Happened Here

Kevin Brownlow/Andrew Mollo 1963 Occupied London film with scenes of Nazis in Notting Hill.

**The Blue Lamp** Basil Dearden 1950 After murdering *Dixon of Dock Green* on Harrow Road, Dirk Bogarde is pursued along Ladbroke Grove and Lancaster Road.

## Seven Days to Noon

John Boulting/Roy Boulting 1950 An atomic scientist threatening to blow up London unless his work stops is shot at St John's church on Ladbroke Grove.

## The Lavender Hill Mob

Charles Crichton 1951 The other great post-war car chase concludes with the police cars converging in a pile-up at the junction of Bramley and Freston Rd.

## 10 Rillington Place

Richard Fleischer 1971 set in early 50s Adaptation of Ludovic Kennedy's book of the case of Notting Hill's most notorious address.



## Absolute Beginners

Julien Temple 1986 Musical adaptation of the Colin MacInnes novel featuring the 1958 race riots as a *West Side Story* dance sequence.

**Sapphire** Basil Dearden 1959 Racial prejudice is examined during a police investigation into the murder of a West Indian girl. The black suspect is beaten up by Teds in Notting Dale.

**Scandal** Michael Caton-Jones 1989 set in early 60s 50 years ago the Profumo affair rocked the nation with accompanying Rachman slum housing revelations.



## The L-Shaped Room

Bryan Forbes 1962 The seedy exoticism of the Rachman slums was captured at the time in the film of Lynne Reid-Banks' novel, starring Leslie Caron.

**West Eleven** Michael Winner 1963 The year of the Profumo affair, *The Furnished Room* novel by Laura del Rivo was partly set on Colville Terrace, starring Alfred Lynch.

## A Hard Day's Night

Richard Lester 1964 Ringo Starr runs into a shop on the corner of All Saints and Lancaster Road. Then all the Beatles run in and out of the police station (the old St John's church school) on Walmer Rd.

**The Nanny** Seth Holt 1965 Bette Davis on Latimer Road in 1964 before the area was demolished to make way for the Westway roundabout.

**The Knack and How to Get It** Richard Lester 1965 Michael Crawford stars as a landlord on Pottery Lane, renting rooms to Ray Brooks, Donal Donnelly and Rita Tushingham.

**Quadrophenia** Franc Roddam 1979 set in mid 60s The mod revival film of the Who's 'Quadrophenia' album featuring Freston Road scenes.

**Alfie** Lewis Gilbert 1966 Michael Caine speaks to the camera at Notting Hill Gate.

**Blow Up** Michelangelo Antonioni 1966 David Hemmings uses a studio on Prince's Place to photograph Vanessa Redgrave and co.



**Georgy Girl** Silvio Narizzano 1966 Charlotte Rampling gives birth at St Charles Hospital.

**Jemima and Johnny** Lionel Ngakane 1966 The adventures of a young black girl and a white boy in Notting Hill.

**Morgan A Suitable Case for Treatment** Karel Reisz 1966 Campden Hill marital farce starring David Warner and Vanessa Redgrave.

**Bedazzled** Stanley Donen 1967 Pete Cook and Dudley Moore appear on Southam Street. Dudley: "Where are we? Is this hell?" Pete: "Just my London headquarters."

**Otley** Dick Clement 1968 Tom Courtenay stars as an antiques trader who gets caught up in a spy caper.

**Performance** Donald Cammell/Nic Roeg 1970 shot in 1968 25 Powis Square stars as Mick Jagger's house in the classic Notting Hill hippy film.



**The File of the Golden Goose** Sam Wanamaker 1969 Yul Brynner follows Charles Gray along Westbourne Grove.

**The Italian Job** Peter Collinson 1969 Michael Caine appears round the back of Alice's antiques shop in Denbigh Close mews.

**Leo the Last** John Boorman 1970 Marcello Mastroianni brings about a 'firework revolution', in which his house on the site of Lancaster West Estate is destroyed.

**Withnail and I** Bruce Robinson 1987 set in 1969 Richard E Grant and Paul McGann are chased out of the Tavistock pub on Tavistock Crescent. Their house is off Freston Road.

**Duffer** Joseph Despins/William Dumaresq 1971 Proto-*Eraserhead* Notting Hill S&M oddity.

**Ooh You Are Awful** Cliff Owen 1972 Dick Emery and Pat Coombs live at 9 Stanley Crescent.

**The Satanic Rites of Dracula** Alan Gibson 1973 Hammer horror known in the US as *Dracula is Alive and Well and Living In London*, in which Satanic bikers kidnap a girl on Bard Road.

**Stephie and Son** Cliff Owen 1972 **Stephie and Son Ride Again** Peter Sykes 1973 Oil Drum Lane is on Adela Street off Kensal Road. Harold gets married at St John's church.

**A Bigger Splash** Jack Hazan/David Mingay 1973 David Hockney docu-drama partly set on Powis Terrace.

**The Tamarind Seed** Blake Edwards 1974 Another spy movie starring Julie Andrews and Omar Sharif with a scene in Barnett's toyshop on Elgin Crescent.

**Hennessy** Don Sharp 1975 Rod Steiger on St John's Gardens.

**The Passenger** Michelangelo Antonioni 1975 Jack Nicholson on Lansdowne Crescent.

**Pressure** Horace Ove 1975 The major 70s Notting Hill film, featuring a reggae soundtrack and the Caribbean store at 194 Kensington Park Road.

**The Moon Over the Alley** Joseph Despins/William Dumaresq 1975 Gritty cult mid 70s Notting Hell film.

**Tommy** Ken Russell 1975 The Who's rock opera, filmed at Lee International Studios in Kensal.

**The Squeeze** Michael Apted 1977 Stacy Keach and Freddie Starr search the area for a kidnapped girl on a pub crawl concluding in a shoot-out on Freston Road.

**Sid and Nancy** Alex Cox 1986 set in late 70s Gary Oldman as Sid headbutts the wall of what would become the Heart FM radio station on Freston Road.



**Breaking Glass** Brian Gibson 1980 Dodi Fayed produced new wave film in which skinheads attack a march under the Westway roundabout.

**The Final Conflict** Graham Baker 1981 *The Omen 3* film featuring the most notorious local horror scene, in which the pram goes down the hill and is hit by a taxi on Lansdowne Rd.

**Betrayal** David Jones 1982 Jeremy Irons meets Patricia Hodge in the Bramley Arms.

**Hell W10** Joe Strummer 1983 The Clash gangster home-movie.

**National Lampoon's European Vacation** Amy Heckerling 1985 Chevy Chase drives on the wrong side of the road on Addison Avenue.

**Half Moon Street** Bob Swain 1986 Sigourney Weaver plays an 80s Christine Keeler.

**Sammy and Rosie Get Laid** Stephen Frears 1987 Hanif Kureishi's 80s state of the nation address featuring a travellers camp by the Westbourne Park curve of the Westway.

**American Roulette** Maurice Hatton 1988 Andy Garcia appears at Latimer Road station.

**Madame Sousatzka** John Schlesinger 1988 Shirley Maclaine on Stanley Crescent.

**For Queen and Country** Martin Stellman 1988 Denzel Washington in Kensal under Trelick.

**I Hired a Contract Killer** Aki Kaurismaki 1990 Jean-Pierre Leaud meets Margi Clarke in the Warwick.

**London Kills Me** Hanif Kureishi 1991 The Notting Hill acid-house film featuring scenes in Golborne, the First Floor bar and a former property of Michael Heseltine on Chepstow Villas.

54 participants aged 16-19 were selected from across the country to take part in the two-week residential Film Academy aimed at hot-housing young film-making talent. They were given the daunting task of making short films from scratch with just two days to shoot and two days to edit using scripts written by NFTS screenwriting students.

Working in six teams of nine, they developed the scripts for screen, auditioned actors, set up budgets and film schedules, recce'd locations and directed, produced, filmed and edited the short films in time for them to be screened at the BFI in front of an audience of film industry VIPs.
